SKB will arrange free transportation for the visits. During the day you will have the opportunity to visit **two of the** facilities. Before lunch you can choose between Clab or Oskarshamn NPP and in the afternoon all participants will visit Äspö HRL.

Please note that the tour will be arranged on a first come first served basis. This means you may not have your preferred choice.

Please note that you have to present a valid passport (foreign nationals) or photo identification at the security check in order to enter the facilities.

Important information when visiting our facilities

Visitor services at our facilities are an important part of the comprehensive work we conduct to inform the public about nuclear power and the management of Sweden's nuclear waste. Regarding the visit, please find some important information below.

Clab, Central Interim Storage Facility (approx. 2.5 h)

The visit starts with passport/ID and security control. This is followed by information and a guided tour of the facility. Possibilities to sit or visit a restroom are limited during the tour. Stairs and elevators occur. You are not allowed to bring camera, cell phones or handbags.

Oskarshamn, Unit 3 (app. 2.5 h)

The visit starts with passport/ID and security control. This is followed by a short presentation and a guided tour of the facility. Possibilities to sit or visit a restroom are limited during the tour. Stairs and elevators occur. You are not allowed to bring camera, cell phone or handbags.

Äspö Hard Rock Laboratory, HRL (approx. 2.5 h)

The visit starts with passport/ID control and information about the facility. This is followed by a guided tour underground, down to a depth of 450 metres. Bus and/or elevator may be used. Please note that long walks underground in steep slopes may occur. Cameras are allowed.

For the safety of each visitor the following regulations must be respected when visiting our facilities:

- ***Each person has to be able to walk without support.***
- ***No wheel chairs, walkers, crutches or sticks are permitted.***
- ***Alcohol may not be consumed before or during the visit.***
- ***We recommend comfortable shoes and casual clothing.***
